Between 2018-2023 the Tarago Catchment Healthy Farms Program supported a 4 year demonstration to increase understanding on how multi species pasture established with Soilkee technology may be used to benefit both pasture growth and species composition, soil health and animal productivity.

Peter Ronalds will share the results of the demonstration, and Cathy will show us the paddock, multi-species pastures, and the livestock. An interesting morning is assured!
